Recent additions to the library are listed below:

Non-Fiction Books:

- **A Praying Life** by Paul Miller. (248.32) "*Pastors Pick*". Christians sometimes prioritize productivity over time in prayer—and experience anxiety, joylessness, and fear as a result. If prayerlessness often marks your life, *A Praying Life* is for you. Miller offers practical, down-to-earth advice on how to talk to God in the midst of your daily routines. Learn to speak from a childlike faith, live your Father's story, understand unanswered petitions, and more.
- **Basic Christianity** by John Stott. (230) "*Pastors Pick*". John Stott in *Basic Christianity* clearly defines the fundamental claims of Christianity and describes what that should look like in the daily lives of believers. He explores who Christ is, humanity's need because of sin, what Christ has done, and how we should respond. This book is a sound guide for anyone desiring an intellectually satisfying presentation of the Christian faith in a straightforward manner.
- **Social Sanity in an Insta World** edited by Sarah Eekhoff Zylstra (248.4) Join nine authors as they explore social media's potential and pitfalls---along with the biblical principles we need to honor the Lord online.
- **God is Still Good** by Katie Faris (248.84). *God Is Still Good* invites women to experience God's comfort and grace through the sorrows of motherhood and leads them to put their hope in Christ, despite the unexpected trials of life.
- Letter to the American Church by Eric Metaxas (261.7). The author of a bestselling biography of Dietrich Bonhoeffer, Eric Metaxas reveals the haunting similarities between today's American Church and the German Church of the 1930s. Echoing the German martyr's prophetic call, he exhorts his fellow Christians to repent of their silence in the face of evil.

- Like a River: Finding the Faith and Strength to Move Forward after Loss and Heartache by Granger Smith. Triumphant new life can be birthed out of tragedy---country singer Granger Smith knows this!
